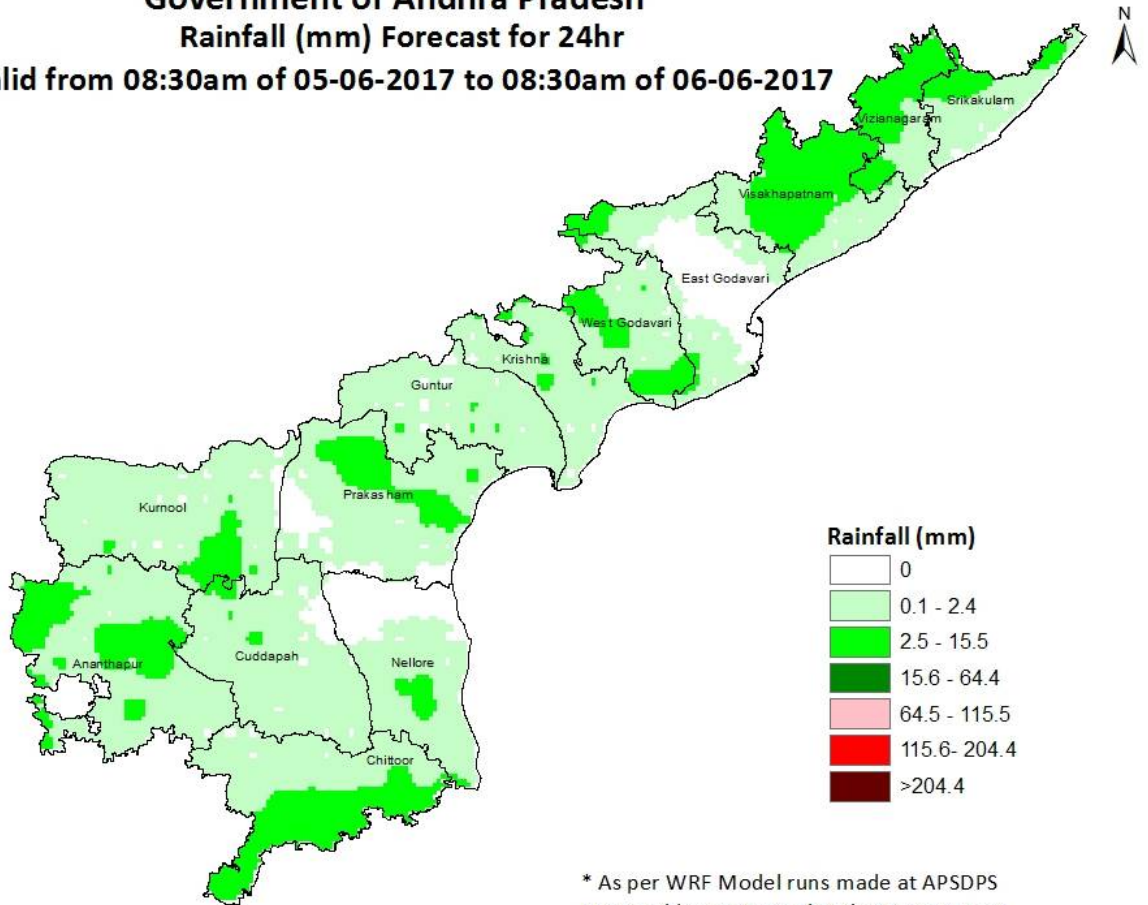

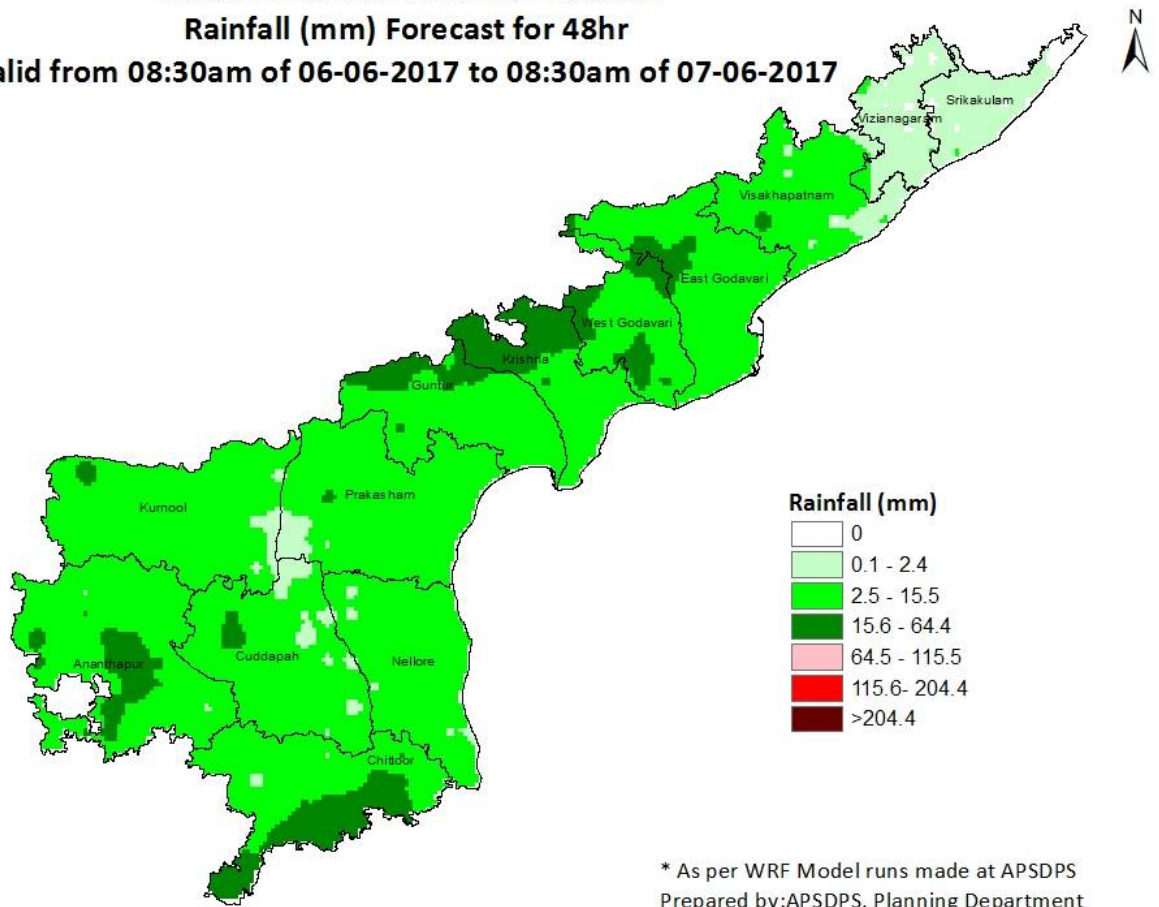
Spatial Distribution: 76-100 % Widespread (WE/Most Places), 51-75% Fairly Widespread (FWS/Many Places),
